Adventure Camp 2020: COVID-19 Prevention Procedures Enterprise Parks and Recreation Department

New procedures have been put in place to attempt to reduce risks for campers and staff during the COVID-19 outbreak. Please carefully read the new procedures below which will be in effect until further notice from the Enterprise Parks and Recreation (EPRD) Director.

Contactless Drop-off and Pick-up

Each camper will receive two Pick-Up Cards to display in vehicle windshields to indicate which child is being dropped off/picked up. During drop off, each child will have their temperature checked. If the temperature is 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, the child will not be admitted to camp.

If a Pick-Up Card is not displayed in the windshield during drop off or pick up, the driver will be asked to park in a spot in front of the Recreation Center and wait for the Camp Supervisor to come to their window to check their identification.

If a parent/guardian would like to drop-off or pick-up a camper outside of the regularly scheduled times, the driver should park in front of the Recreation Center and call 334-348-2684 to inform staff of their arrival. A Camp Supervisor will then come out to the car to address the camper pick-up/drop-off.

Temperature Screenings

All staff and camper temperatures will be screened before camp begins and after lunch every day. Staff will monitor itself and campers for any other COVID-19 symptoms. Staff with a fever of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or more will immediately be sent home. Campers with a fever of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or more will be separated from the rest of the camp and the parents will be called to pick up their camper immediately.

Group Separation

Camp will be split into separate groups. These groups will be kept in separate rooms and will do all activities separately. There will not be joined group assemblies or joined group field trips. Each camper will have their own cubby space and set of supplies. These will not be shared among different campers. Within their separate rooms, campers will be asked to keep a 6-foot distance between one another to the best of their ability. Employees shall not knowingly allow parents or other guests to congregate within six feet of a person from another household. Facilities shall also take reasonable steps to prevent parents or other guests from congregating in common areas.

Facial Coverings

Employees will wear a mask or other facial covering that covers his or her nostrils and mouth at all times, when in regular interaction with campers and guests.

Sanitation

EPRD will take reasonable steps, where practicable, to regularly disinfect frequently used items and surfaces. Hand sanitizing stations will be established inside the Recreation Center for campers and staff to utilize throughout the day, especially after drop-off and lunch. Camp counselors will be provided travel-size disinfectant for activities outside of the Recreation Center.
